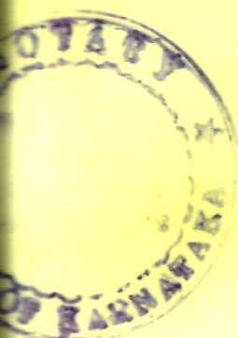


THE PROCEEDINGS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA.

Sub: Recognition of Nightingale School of Nursing,
Bidar -regarding.

Read: Dated 12-01-2004, No.KA.RA.SHU.PA/1607/2003,
Karnataka Nursing council letter.

Preamble:



1. That as per the Section 23 of the Karnataka Nurses, Midwives and Health visitors Act of 1961 Read with Rule 50 of the Karnataka state Nursing Council Bye-Laws, the Nightingale School of Nursing, Bidar has submitted an application to the Karnataka state Nursing Council, as per Sec.23 the Council has constituted committee for inspecting the school and obtained its Report. In the light of the Recommendations contained in the Inspection Team's Report this case was considered by the Council and submitted the proposal to the Govt., the Govt. has considered this proposal and decided to grant permission to start the course of Diploma in Nursing from 2004-05 with subject to few conditions which has to be fulfilled compulsorily and to some Rules.

That, as per section 23 of the Karnataka Nursing, Midwives and Health visitors Act-1961. Read with Karnataka State Nursing Council Bye-Laws Rule-50 and considering the Recommendations the Government has granted permission and recognised to the Nightingale school of Nursing, Bidar commencing from the academic year 2004-05 with an intake capacity of 50 students to the Diploma in Nursing only. This Recognition is subject to the following conditions.

CONDITIONS

1. Karnataka state Nursing council and Indian Nursing Council's Recognition shall be obtained.
2. Indian Nursing Council and Karnataka state Nursing Council's prescribed curriculum and Midwife and Nursing Examination Board's Action plan has to be followed.
3. Karnataka state nursing council and Indian Nursing Council prescribed Rules/Regulations has to be compulsorily followed.
4. To provide the Basic facilities as per the guidance of the Indian Nursing Council and Karnataka Nursing Council.
5. The Government will not provide any Aid to these Institution at any cost.
6. The Institutions shall appoint only the Qualified and Experienced Teaching and Non-Teaching faculty.
7. To provide the Nursing and Medical Journals and the pertaining subject Books and Magzines in the Library to the Students.
8. As per the Indian Nursing council's Rules/Regulations the Institution shall have its own Hospital within the 5-years.
9. The Students has to be Admitted as per the 2003 Karnataka Diploma in General Nursing Midwifery/Psychiatry Course or as per the direction of the Govt. from time to time for taking admissions of the students.
